- Each team must have an identified FA FIRST AIDER prior to any game or training session.
- Club Address - Sports Field, Main Street, Tysoe, Warwickshire
- Post code - CV35 0SR
- DEFIBRILLATOR – Location Tysoe sports pavilion
- You must have a mobile phone with you
- In an emergency dial 999 or 112 (gives GPS to emergency services)
- Nearest Hospitals – Horton General Hospital A & E, Oxford Rd, Banbury. OX16 9AL Telephone: 0300 304 7777
- Journey Time 21 mins, distance 11 miles
- Nearest Hospitals – Warwick Hospital A & E, Lakin Road, Warwick. CV34 5BW. Telephone: 01926 495321
- Journey Time 33 mins, distance 19 miles

Emergency Action Policy

- The Team Manager will ensure the following:
- Know that the first aider has a FA FIRST AIDER qualification that is in date
- Your first aid kit is with you and in date
- Your mobile phone is available and charged
- Know the post code for the pitch you are playing at
- That you check your own player cards each game for player medical conditions and that it has an emergency contact number
- You have all player MEDICAL EQUIPMENT in a safe place for medical conditions
- The match day environment is safe and appropriate for football
- Have a colleague who can support you should an incident occur
- Act in line with the FA First Aid Qualification should you need to
- NO FIRST AIDER – NO MATCH NO MEDICAL EQUIPMENT – CAN'T PLAY
